

Runner's HI 20K, RACE DAY INFORMATION

LOCATION: Barbers Point Elementary in Kalaeloa 3001 Boxer Road, Kapolei HI 96707

PARKING: parking is available anywhere around the starting and finishing area along the road on the grass as long as your car is not interfering with the race course.

RESTROOMS: Portable restrooms will be near the start/finish area at the West corner of Tulagi and Roosevelt.

START: 0600 start time; plan to arrive at the park at least 1 hour before the start to be sure you get parking. Runners will assemble at the starting line (near the finish/staging area) 10 minutes before start for race instructions. Participants who do not cross the start line or cross more than 10 minutes after start will not receive an official time.

RACE NUMBERS: Please wear your race number on the front where it is clearly visible.

TIMING: Chips will be attached to the back of your bib number and distributed to runners at packet pick up. You must wear your bib/Timing Chip and cross the mats to ensure a race time. Follow the instructions of the volunteers as you approach the start area to begin the race. After the run, you do not need to return your bib/timing chip after crossing the finish line. If you forget your bib race day, there is a \$5 charge for a new chip and to re-assign you a new bib number.

COURSE: IAAF/USATF Certified 20K (20K = 12.44 miles)

The race starts on Tulagi Road inside the start/finish shoot. The route heads north making a right turn on Roosevelt Ave. The route proceeds on Roosevelt Ave and then make a right turn on Enterprise St. Then make a right turn on Midway/Boxer Road. Then make a right turn on Tulagi Road to complete one full loop. The whole route consists of 4 large clockwise loops of 3 miles each loop. After the 4th loop, you will cross the finish line on Tulagi Road.

AID STATIONS: Come well hydrated for the race. There are 2 aid stations on this 3-mile loop so water and Gatorade will be available every 1.5 miles. One aid Station will be on Tulagi Road and the other on Enterprise Road after the FBI building. Refreshments will be provided at the finish line.

AWARDS CEREMONY: The award ceremony will be at 0815 near finish area. Awards not picked up will be available at Boca Hawaii for two weeks following the race.
